Funds Available

- \$12,500 in down payment and closing cost assistance available for a limited time!
- Combination of a fixed rate 3% down payment assistance loan of \$10,000 and closing cost grant of \$2,500.

Program Eligibility

- Purchase of a home in Marshall County, Kansas, of \$50,000 or greater including existing, manufactured, or new construction.

- Limited funds available on a first come, first served basis.
